The WYDE initiative champions inclusive democracy, with a strong focus on advocacy and research as crucial components of the project. By strengthening the voices of young leaders, especially women, WYDE Freedoms aims to foster a more open and democratic global society where human rights are respected and upheld. The project's main objective is to prepare young leaders through targeted capacity development, address their protection needs, and facilitate sharing of knowledge to promote freedom of assembly and association.
